If you have an emergency after hours (severe pain, you cannot eat or drink for more than a day because of morning sickness, vaginal bleeding, you think you might be in labor or preterm labor) call the main phone number (303-322-2240) and follow the instructions to reach the doctor on call. The doctor on call will call you back within 30 minutes—if not, page again. Occasionally things happen—the service isn't working or a pager is not getting a message. If you have a true emergency and can't get through to the answering service please call labor and delivery at Pres/St. Lukes (303-839-7380) and let them know you have an emergency—they have all the contact numbers for the doctors and will let them know you can't get through to the answering service. Please call about non-urgent matters during regular office hours.
